



General conditions

1. The BBQ trailer is only to be used in the Nelson area – this extends from Hira in the north to Richmond township in the south.
2. The BBQ trailer is not to be sub-leased, hired or loaned to a third party during the period of the hire.

Safety

3. Please ensure you transport and use the BBQ trailer in a safe manner:
 - a. Ensure you obey all traffic and parking regulations and ensure the driver is insured. You will be responsible for the payment of any fines or infringements incurred, and any damage incurred.
 - b. Ensure the gas tap is closed tightly after use and the gas cylinders properly secured at all times.
 - c. Ensure the trailer is parked on a flat surface and the wheel chocks we've provided are placed behind the wheels to prevent it from moving.
 - d. When you move the trailer you must wear closed-toe shoes as the trailer is heavy and could cause injury to your feet.
 - e. The BBQ should not be moved when lit or hot.
 - f. The BBQ should be attended at all times when lit and an adult/adults must supervise its operation. No unattended children should be allowed near the BBQ.
4. We have provided a fire extinguisher and first aid kit to use in the event of an emergency/injury. Please let us know if these are used so they can be refilled.
5. Neighbourhood Support Nelson accepts no liability whatsoever for personal injury or property damage arising out of the operation of the BBQ or trailer while under the care of the user.

Security

6. Please ensure the BBQ trailer is secured at all times when it's parked with the wheel clamp. Please park in a safe place. Note: if the BBQ trailer is stolen it is only partially covered by insurance.
7. Please ensure the BBQ trailer is not left unattended when in use at events.



Cleaning

8. Please clean the BBQ thoroughly after use so that it is in a fit condition to be used as soon as you return it. Cleaning instructions are taped to the inside wall of the trailer.
9. Failure to clean the BBQ adequately will result in the user forfeiting their bond.

Damage

10. Any damage to the BBQ trailer or loss of equipment must be reported to Neighbourhood Support Nelson as soon as it is returned, so it can be dealt with. We have taped a list of all the equipment to the inside wall of the trailer.
11. Damage to the BBQ trailer and its equipment may result in the user forfeiting their bond.
12. Any damage that necessitates Neighbourhood Support Nelson lodging an insurance claim will result in the user paying the insurance excess. The standard excess is \$400 and the excess for exemplary damage (wilful damage) is \$5000.
13. If the trailer is stolen during the period of hire the user will be responsible for the costs of replacement not covered by insurance.
